What is this draft?

- SIP related extensions to support ICE
 - An option tag (ice)
 - A media feature tag (sip.ice)
- Use cases
 - Registration – UA informs registrar if it supports ICE
 - Allows incoming ICE calls to proxy to go to “ICE gateway” if receiving devices don’t support ICE
 - Uses media feature tag
 - INVITE – Require far end to support ICE
 - Useful if default candidate really shouldn’t be used – would choose something else if I know you are not ICE
 - Uses option tag in Require

Important to Note

- Initial motivation was offerless INVITE
 - UAS can construct its offer with ICE if UAC indicating ICE support, otherwise not
 - However this does NOT work – fails in 3pcc cases where UAC and answerer are not the same
 - This use case is not described
- Option tag not used with Supported, just Require
 - Media feature tag in REGISTER
 - ICE attributes themselves in offers
 - Media feature tag in OPTIONS response (not documented!)
- Worried about two tags with similar meaning – try to separate cases
 - Media feature tag refers to actually doing ICE
 - Option tag refers to an empty specification that you support if you also do ICE
